## **Legislative Session Update**

After taking up and passing the last of the omnibus budget as well as the tax bill, the House adjourned sine die early this morning, July 1<sup>st</sup>. The Senate did not adjourn sine die, and instead adjourned until Friday, July 2<sup>nd</sup>. The tax bills were the last bills to be passed by both bodies this morning. Metro Cities will provide a comprehensive special session legislative update via the newsletter early next week.
